

## CourtCall Reminders – SMS Terms and Conditions

1. The CourtCall Reminders program sends text reminders at a set time period before CourtCall Appearances and provides conference codes to allow the recipient to join the court session.
2. You can cancel the SMS service at any time. Just text "STOP" to the short code. After you send the SMS message "STOP" to us, we will send you an SMS message to confirm that you have been unsubscribed. After this, you will no longer receive these reminders or any other SMS messages from us. If you want to join again, just sign up as you did the first time and we will start sending SMS messages to you again.
3. If you are experiencing issues with the CourtCall messaging program you can reply with the keyword HELP for more assistance, or you can get help directly at (888) 882-6878.
4. Carriers are not liable for delayed or undelivered messages.
5. As always, message and data rates may apply for any messages sent to you from us and to us from you. Message frequency varies: you will receive messages only as requested before scheduled CourtCall appearances. If you have any questions about your text plan or data plan, it is best to contact your wireless provider/Carrier.
